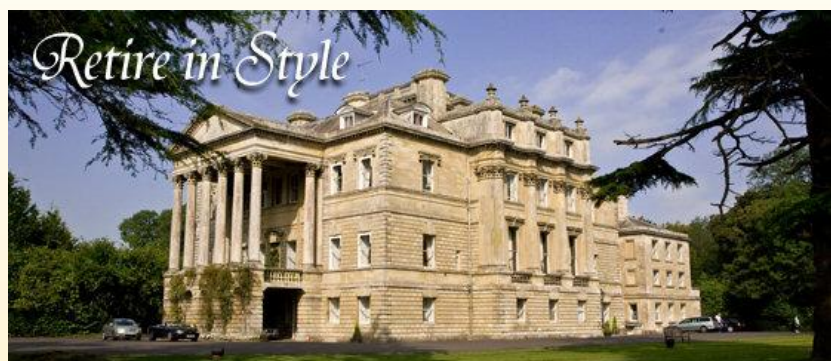


Case Study
